Two 18 Hole Competitions

1. Best Ball Gross/Net Format Rules

- Record each player's gross score on scorecard.
- The scorer's table will select one best ball net score.
- The scorer's table will select one best ball gross score that is different from their best ball net score.
- The team score for each hole is the total of net and gross balls.

Course Rules

- Proper golfing attire required - collared shirts, slacks, or long shorts.
- Metal spikes not permitted.

Competition Rules

- You may register as an individual or as a four person team. If registering as an individual, the Chapter will select teams based on the handicaps provided. We will balance the teams as evenly as possible.
- **Competition type must be selected at time of registration.** If you register as a team, all members must participate in the same type of competition.
- USGA rules govern play.
- Men will play from the white tees, women from the red tees.

Player names and handicaps to be confirmed in early May.

2. Progressive Scramble Format Rules

Men will start from the White tees and Ladies will start from the Red tees.

- If your team shoots Par on a hole, you continue to play on those tees.
- If your team scores Birdie or better on a hole, your team *will move back* one set of tees for the next hole. For example, if the Men had just played from the White tees and the Women had played from the Red tees, the Men would move back to the Blue and Women to the White tees to start the next hole.
- If your team scores Bogie or worse on a hole, your team *will move forward* one set of tees.
- You will continue this throughout the round.

On Par 3's, there will be one set of tees for each gender. The Men always hit from the White and the Ladies always hit from the Reds. You then return back to the set of tees you were playing, factoring in the result from the Par 3. For example, if you were on the White tees when you reached the Par 3 and get a Birdie, you would move back to the Blue tees on the next hole.

After each member of your group has teed off from his or her respective tee, pick the best shot out of the group. All players will then hit their next shot from *within one club length* from that spot. This continues until your team has holed out.

EACH PLAYER MUST USE AT LEAST 3 TEE SHOTS AND IS LIMITED TO USING 6 TEE SHOTS ON THE DAY.
